Re-opening

Academic Excellence

This year the Curriculum has been redesigned to cater to the needs of the students' learning gaps with a particular focus on reading and writing skills, strengthening Numeracy and Scientific aptitude at the elementary levels.

Science experiments and STEM activities were carried out in virtual labs and students were encouraged to perform them using materials available at home.

Enrichment activities were planned to inculcate life skills and values in the children which they would have developed through interpersonal interaction at school.

We registered our first batch of students of grade 9 with the CBSE who are all set to take their Board exams in Grade 10 in the coming year.

We not only focus upon the intellectual development of our future generation, but also take care of their emotional and behavioural development in their early ages inculcating sound moral values, responsibility and social awareness through different co-curricular activities like quiz, role plays, talk shows, speeches, advertising and marketing, cooking without fire, breakfast time etc which were some of the most popular activities on the show
