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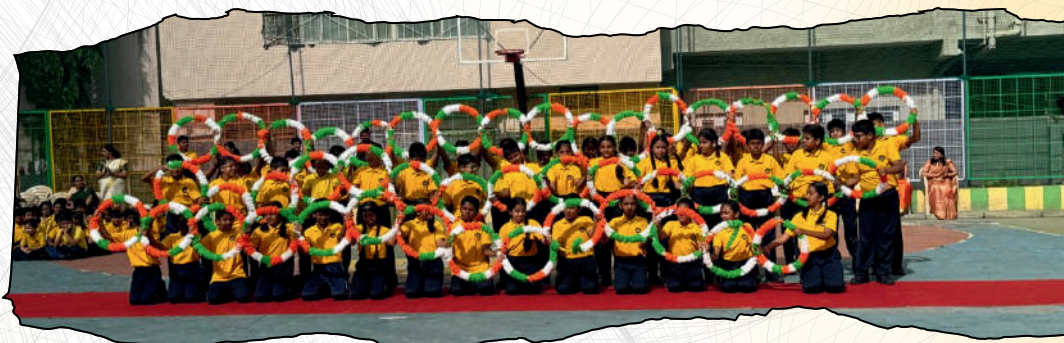
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78th Independence Day Celebration

Rangoli Competition



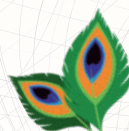

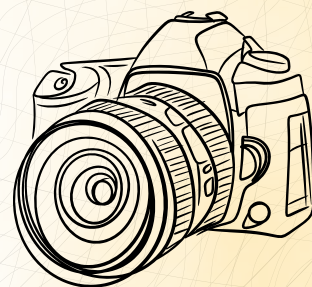

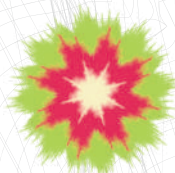
World Photography Day

Grade 4 & 5 - STEM Activity



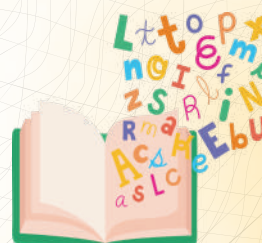

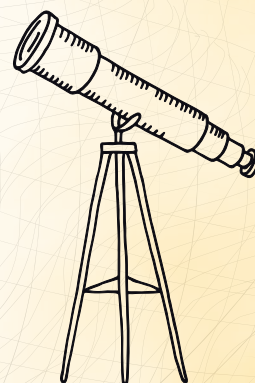


Club Activity

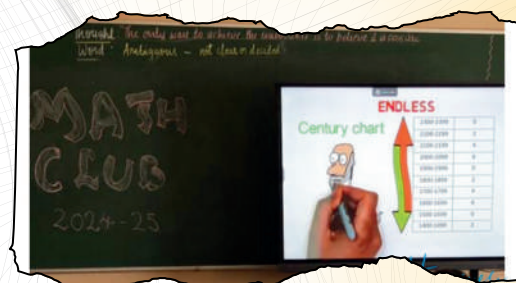
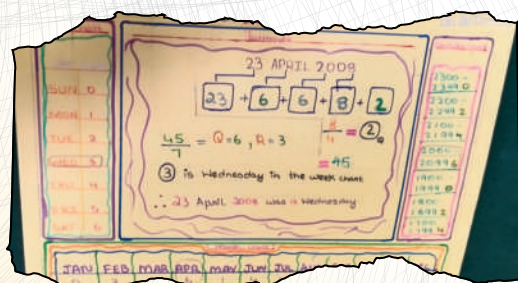
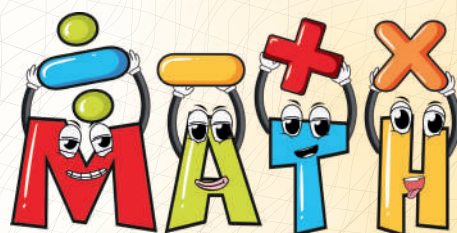


Club Activity

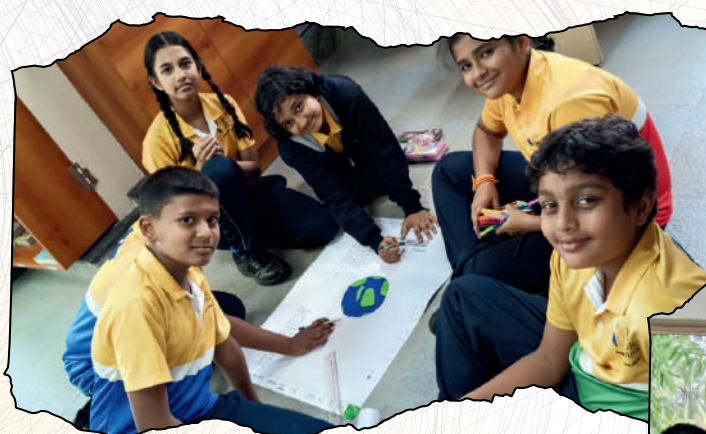

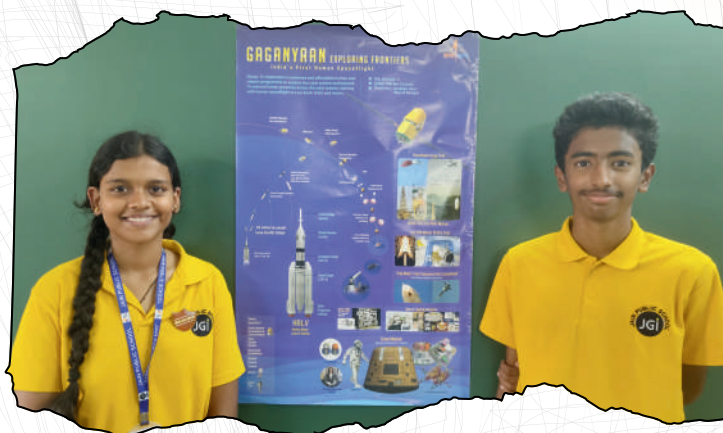


Eco Club

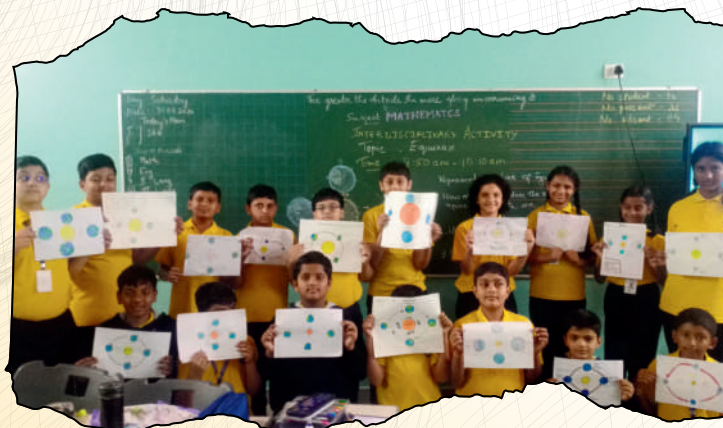
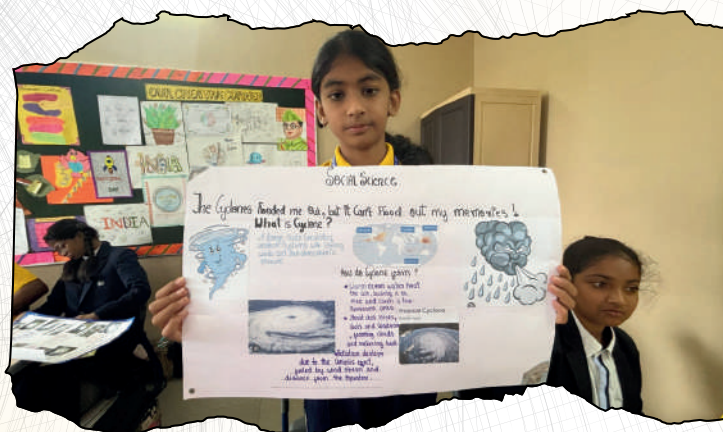

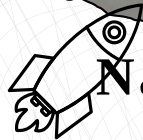
Grade-10 Parent-Teacher Meeting

The combination of captivating sky shows, interactive exhibits, and practical workshops rendered the visit both engaging and enlightening.



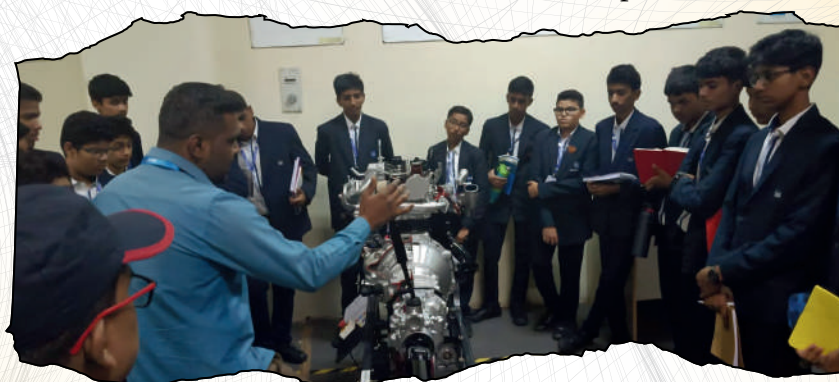
